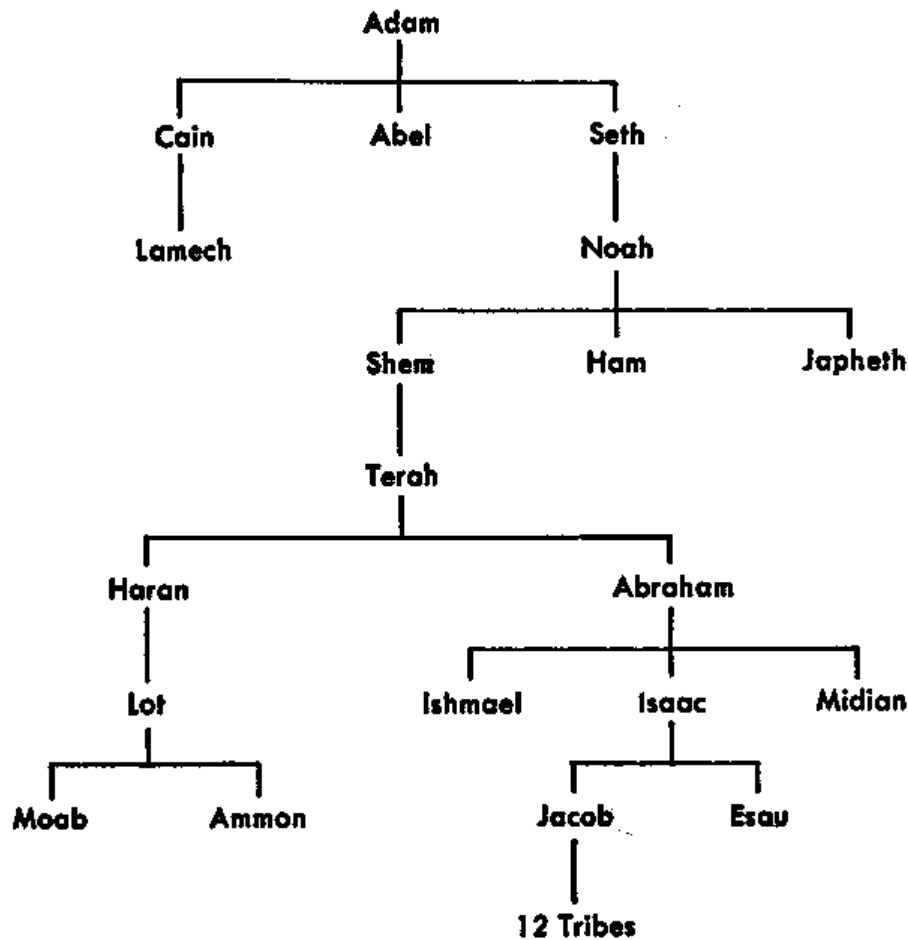
“For Your salvation I wait, O LORD.”
 Genesis 49:18

I. Who is Jacob ultimately waiting for?

The salvation Jacob waited for was ultimately fulfilled in Christ.

Genesis 3:15 refers to the coming Messiah as the promised _____. The LORD God said to the serpent: “And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on the head, and you shall bruise him on the heel.”

Shiloh (Strong's 7886) is an epithet (eh-puh-thet) or cryptogram for the Messiah.
"Genesis 49:10 is normally regarded as a messianic prophecy." ~ Zodhiates

"Shiloh, that promised Seed in whom the earth should be blessed, that peaceable and prosperous One, or Saviour, he shall come of Judah. **Thus dying Jacob at a great distance saw Christ's day, and it was his comfort and support on his death-bed.**" ~ Matthew Henry's Concise Commentary

God promises Abraham in Genesis 12:3 "All the nations will be blessed in you."

Galatians 3:8-9 "The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying "All the nations will be blessed in you."
