*justice-4941-mishpat-distinguish right from wrong and apply whatever means necessary to bring about restoration, deliverance, and salvation. Freedom for the oppressed, not punishment of the perpetrator, is the more important result of justice. God corrected His people with mishpat because His purpose was saving them not destroying them.
