•	The wise man hears and acts- Matthew 7:24-27	
•	Listen with a heart- Romans 10:17, * Hebrews 4:2	
•	Make your ear attentive to wisdom- Proverbs 2:2-5	
	o Desiring to know and	
•	be sure of what you hear. Acts 17:11" for they (the Bereans) received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see whether these things were so ." (Emphasis added)	
•	Don't stop growing. Keep maturing. Hebrews 5: 13-14, Hebrews 6:1 "let us press on to"

	The Good Shepherd. "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me;" ~John 10:27	
	Discern His voice- by meditating on His words. Joshua 1:8, "This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night."	
	Pray for Him to open your ears. When he speaks are you listening? 1 Samuel 3:10	

*	Sometimes when he speaks it's in "a still small voice" 1 Kings 19:13 KJV
