



## Hebrews Lesson 10 Chapter 10

*One of the most amazing realities that is being presented in Hebrews is that the God Most High, the Creator of all, the Holy One desires to have fellowship and relationship with His creation. That truth is seen in the details of the old covenant and most expressly in the new covenant. Both covenants dramatically reveal the extent that God will go to unveil Himself to them and redeem them back to Himself. The author appeals to what his audience does know about God to dramatically put Him on display before them in a way they had never seen before. He doesn't want them to settle for "milk" that diminishes His glory. He wants them to grow up and chew on the "meat" of the truth about the remarkable Sovereign they serve. God has so much more to offer than what they were settling for. He wants to take them beyond earthly*

*shadows to the blazing glory of majesty in the heavenlies. The reality of the superiority of Christ delves into the wisdom and beauty of God's overall plan of redemption that moves far beyond the realm of following old covenant specifics. Man is broken, the old covenant is broken, and God will redeem both through a new covenant established in His own faithfulness not human ability. This reality is what led the Apostle Paul to be moved to worship in Romans 11:32-33, 36... "For God has shut up all in disobedience that He might show mercy to all. Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways! ... For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever. Amen!"*
