I. God's Sovereignty-review

Sovereignty means that God is in control over His creation dealing with the governance of it. It means God is ruling at all times in all places over everything to every degree, and if that were not true, God would cease to be God and cease to be sovereign. Sovereignty means God existed before time and at every point in time past, present, and future guiding history to His predetermined ends to fulfill His decree.
