I. God's Absolutes.

Absolute- "Free from imperfection or limitation; Complete; Unadulterated"

- A. The _____ and _____ Word of God. (John 17:17, Isaiah 40:8) "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness"*
-2 Timothy 3:16
