### *Part 1- The Glory of God revealed in Jesus Christ*

- A. Jesus Christ’s **radiance** and **splendor** \_\_\_\_\_ the glory of the Father. God’s glory is reflected in Jesus Christ. John 1:14 “The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.”
