The law as such may be the criterion or standard for determining what constitutes lawlessness, but at its root lawlessness is rebellion against God, whether viewed as the of one's life or as the specific that demonstrate a determined refusal to acknowledge God." Baker's Evangelical Dictionary Through the category of lawlessness, John clarifies that one cannot sin without declaring oneself to be in direct opposition to God.
