*Sanballat was the acting governor of the area of Samaria and his home was possibly in the region of Ephraim. Although he seems to be a worshipper of Jehovah, his name means "Sin (the moon god) has saved." Tobiah was an Ammonite and probably governed the area east of Judea. He was either a subordinate of Sanballat or in close collaboration with him.*
