The Hebrew word translated "I AM" is Hayah or Ehyeh which means to exist. This has come to be understood as "the one who is, who was, and who is to come, or "the Eternal One." The meaning of the simple name carries the full weight of God's eternal, self-existing, self-sustaining nature.
