<ul> <li>Priest- saw him, passed by on the other side.</li> <li>Levite- saw him, passed by on the other side. (Read Deut. 22:1-4)</li> <li>Samaritan- when he saw him, he compassion.</li> <li>He used his resources to help him</li> <li>He bandaged his wounds</li> <li>Put him on his animal</li> <li>Took him to an inn and cared for him overnight</li> <li>Gives money to ensure his care and guarantees to foot the bill for any extra fees related to his recovery.</li> <li>Read Matthew 25:35-40 "Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for"</li> </ul>
