The God of Truth

"The sum of Your word is truth" Psalm 119:160

The sum of Your word is truth Psaim 119:160
The Hebrew word for truth is emeth. Defined as stability, certainty, truth, trustworthiness.
Truth in this context is not just factual accuracy, but it implies, reliability and
El Emeth, meaning "God of truth" would be a name for God that highlights God's as the source of truth and faithfulness.
Spurgeon said, "God is true, and His word is true."
Part 1 His Word is Absolute Truth
1. The Bible is absolute truth because its author is "The God of Truth"
• The Bible is the only book that has authority because it is the very word of God. Read 1 Thessalonians 1:13
a.) Read Isaiah 65:16
b.) Exodus 34:6 God is in lovingkindness and truth.
c.) Proverbs 30:5 in the ESV says " word of God proves true."
d.) 2 Samuel 7:28 "Now, O Lord God, You are God, and Your words are,"
e.) Jesus said in John 17:17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth."

f.) God's word is absolute. Matthew 5:18 KJV "For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled."
