- 1. God is Trustworthy*
- 2. God is True (Read Psalm 119:142,160)*
- 3. God is Faithful (Psalm 119:90)*
- 4. God is unchangeable*
- 5. God is eternal (Psalm 119:89)*
- 6. God is Light (1 John 1:5) (Psalm 119:105)*
- 7. Pure (Read Psalm 119:140)*

*II. Obedience to the word of the Lord*

- 1. Commitment to God’s word is a \_\_\_\_\_ commitment to scripture.*

*See Psalm 119: 33 ...” And I shall observe it to the \_\_\_\_\_.”*

*Thaddeus Williams said ”Let us read His words so frequently that \_\_\_\_\_ voice becomes the voice in our heads.”*

- 2. My obedience unto your word is worship. John 15:10*

*Psalm 119:48 says, “And I shall lift up my hands to Your commandments, which I love;”*

- 3. \_\_\_\_\_ in His word, fellowship with it, make it your highest priority.*

*You go to the word of the Lord to find the Lord of the word.*

- “Every ‘thou shall’ or ‘thou shall not’ is God’s invitation to you to walk in \_\_\_\_\_ to the way God designed the world.” Matt Chandler*

*III. The paradox in finding freedom in the law of the Lord*

- 1. There is freedom in the law. Psalm 119:45 NIV says, “I will walk about in freedom, for I have sought out your precepts.”*
- 2. \_\_\_\_\_ freedom to disobey God or His law.*

*Antinomianism was an old heresy which could be described as “\_\_\_\_\_ -the – law-ism”. Which says that Christians can live however they want, for the law is in \_\_\_\_\_ way binding for believers.*

- 3. What then is the purpose of law for believers?*
- 4. God did not set His law aside when He \_\_\_\_\_ us. He sent Christ to \_\_\_\_\_ it on our behalf. (2 Cor 5:21)*
- 5. “It is true that we’re no longer under law as a means of acceptance with God; but we are still to see the law as a means of living for God.”*
- 6. Now the Law is written on our \_\_\_\_\_ (Hebrews 10:15-16, Jeremiah 31:33)*
- 7. John Calvin recognized the most important use of the law was to use the law as a guide to what pleases God. As direction for \_\_\_\_\_ in holiness.*
